# The Fourth Annual Mount Diablo Hill Climb Time Trial

## Saturday June 20, 2009

Course: 10k (6.2 mile) time trial up the Northgate side of Mt. Diablo. Course begins at the entry kiosk on Northgate Rd. and finishes at the ranger residence just short of the junction (intersection of Northgate Rd. and Mt Diablo Scenic Bl.) covering over half the total distance to the summit. Climbing with gradients up to 15% begins after 1.5 miles of gentle rollers. Total elevation gain of 1740 ft. Road is good pavement. USA Cycling permits pending.

Directions: From 680 North: Take Ygnacio Valley Rd. exit, right on Ygnacio Valley Rd., right on Walnut Av. (not Walnut Bl.) to end, right on Oak Grove Rd., follow signs to parking. From 680 South: Take Treat Bl. exit, left on N. Main St., first left on Treat Bl., right on Oak Grove Rd., continue straight through roundabout, follow signs to parking. Parking/registration is at Northgate High School at 425 Castle Rock Rd., Walnut Creek.

Additional KOM and QOM prize for fastest times of the day - \$50 each. New men's or women's course record earns another \$100 each.

Entry: Valid USCF license or 1-day license required. Non-licensed racers can apply for a 1-day license at the registration tent. Please allow an extra 20 minutes registration time if you need to purchase a one-day license. All competitors must complete USCF Race Entry & Release Form. Under 18 must have co-signature of a parent or legal guardian.

Registration: ONLINE REGISTRATION ONLY. Registration check-in opens at 7:00am on race day. Online pre-registration is available through June 18 5:00pm via [www.c4racing.org](http://www.c4racing.org). Find your exact start time on June 19 on [www.c4racing.org](http://www.c4racing.org). No mail-in pre-registration. No refunds.

Important: Start ramp is 1.6 miles from parking/registration area at the Mt. Diablo park entry kiosk—allow time to ride from registration to start. Participants will be disqualified for centerline violations, exceeding speed limit on post-race descent, or littering.
